


On a motion by Jerry Schroeder, second by Bill Lewis, a supplement to the interlocal agreement between the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, the Furnas County Extension Board, and the Furnas County Board was approved. The supplement will provide cooperative support to conduct and administer the Cooperative Extension programs in 4-H and Youth Development in Furnas County. RCV: Lewis, Aye; Schroeder, Aye; Tegtman, Aye. The motion was declared carried by Chairman Tegtman.

Nate Stineman, Oxford, representing the Golden Generation Center, Oxford, met with the County Board concerning possible financial support of that organization from Furnas County.

Lance Harter, County Highway Superintendent, Kearney, met with the Board with three agreements, two of which were approved, on a motion by Bill Lewis, second by Jerry Schroeder. Services include site survey, hydraulic assessment, and design + plan preparation for a culvert pipe structure replacement on road 432, between Section 18-T2N, R21W, and Section 13-T2N, R22W, in the amount of \$3450. The second agreement involves the same services for a culvert pipe structure on road 721, between Section 29/32, T4N, R21W, in the amount of \$3150.
